BRADY V. MARYLAND NOTICE


COMES NOW THE STATE OF TEXAS, by and through its Assistant District Attorney, Justin K. Wood, in the above-styled and numbered cause, makes the following disclosure pursuant to the ruling of *Brady v. Maryland*.

Elizabeth Buhay is a Crime Analyst with the Department of Public Safety's Telecommunications Research Analysis Center. Prior to indictment, Ms. Buhay analyzed Dawnna Dukes' AT&T phone records and provided maps of her cell phone activity for the dates Ms. Dukes claimed on her State of Texas travel vouchers between September 2013 and September 2014. One of the dates she analyzed, December 22, 2013, became the basis of Count IV of the Tampering with a Governmental Record indictment in Cause No. D1DC 17-904011.

Ms. Buhay advised she discovered on October 2, 2017, that she mistakenly used cell phone data from October 22, 2013, instead of December 22, 2013, when she originally mapped Ms. Dukes' cell phone activity. When analyzing the accurate data for December 22, 2013, Ms. Buhay stated Ms. Dukes' cell phone indicated activity near downtown Austin, Texas, which puts her within range of the Capitol building. As a result, if the State proceeds to trial in the above styled cause number, the State will move to waive or abandon Count IV of the indictment.

Additionally, on October 4, 2017, Ms. Buhay advised when she originally mapped Ms. Dukes' cell phone activity for the time period of September 2013 to September 2014 she failed to account for daylight savings time.
