Impeaching Donald John Trump, President of the United States, of high
misdemeanors.

Mr. AL GREEN of Texas submitted the following resolution; which was
referred to the Committee on _____

RESOLUTION

Impeaching Donald John Trump, President of the United
States, of high misdemeanors.

- 1 *Resolved*, That Donald John Trump, President of the
- 2 United States is unfit to be President and is impeached
- 3 for high misdemeanors, and that the following articles of
- 4 impeachment be exhibited to the Senate:

- 5 Articles of Impeachment exhibited by the House of
- 6 Representatives of the United States, in the name of itself
- 7 and of the people of the United States, against Donald
- 8 John Trump, President of the United States, in mainte-
- 9 nance and support of its impeachment against him for

1 high misdemeanors committed as President constituting
2 harm to American society to the manifest injury of the
3 people of the United States:

4 ARTICLE I

5 In his capacity as President of the United States, un-
6 mindful of the high duties of his high office and the dig-
7 nity and proprieties thereof, and of the harmony and cour-
8 tesies necessary for stability within the society of the
9 United States, Donald John Trump has with his state-
10 ments done more than insult individuals and groups of
11 Americans, he has harmed the society of the United
12 States, brought shame and dishonor to the office of Presi-
13 dent of the United States, sowing discord among the peo-
14 ple of the United States by associating the majesty and
15 dignity of the presidency with causes rooted in white su-
16 premacy, bigotry, racism, anti-Semitism, white nation-
17 alism, or neo-Nazism on one or more of the following occa-
18 sions:

19 On August 15, 2017, Donald John Trump made a
20 widely published statement characterizing a group of anti-
21 Semites, bigots, racists, white nationalists, and Ku Klux
22 Klansmen who rallied in Charlottesville, Virginia, as “very
23 fine people”.

24 On October 7, 2017, hate groups returned to Char-
25 lottesville, Virginia, at the statue of Robert E. Lee, the
26 Confederate general, chanting “You will not replace us!”

1 Since this event on October 7, the President has made
2 many widely published statements about many things in-
3 cluding, the National Football League, but has not made
4 one widely published statement condemning the hate
5 groups for returning to the place where an innocent person
6 lost her life at the hands of hate.

7 On November 29, 2017, Donald John Trump shared
8 3 videos posted by a leader of a British political party
9 considered by many to be an extremist group. The videos
10 purported to show various violent acts committed by Mus-
11 lims, and were entitled: “Muslim migrant beats up Dutch
12 boy on crutches!”; “Muslim Destroys a Statue of Virgin
13 Mary!”; and “Islamist mob pushes teenage boy off roof
14 and beats him to death!”. The clearly inferable intent of
15 the post was to demonstrate the alleged propensity of
16 Muslim immigrants to engage in violent acts. Even if the
17 videos showed what they purported to, in sharing these
18 videos with his 43,800,000 followers on Twitter, Donald
19 John Trump’s dissemination of such material evinces an
20 invidious intent to create division within American society.

21 In all of this, the aforementioned Donald John
22 Trump, by his statements, unmindful of the high duties
23 of his high office and the dignity and proprieties thereof,
24 and of the harmony, respect, and courtesies necessary for
25 stability within the society of the United States, has un-

1 dermed the integrity of his office, has sown discord
2 among the people of the United States, has brought disre-
3 pute, contempt, ridicule and disgrace on the Presidency,
4 has acted in a manner antithetical to the cause of a just
5 society, has betrayed his trust as President to the manifest
6 injury of the people of the United States, and committed
7 a high misdemeanor in office.

8 Therefore, Donald John Trump by causing such
9 harm to the society of the United States is unfit to be
10 President and warrants impeachment, trial, and removal
11 from office.

12 ARTICLE II

In his capacity as President of the United States, un-
mindful of the high duties of his high office, of the dignity
and proprieties thereof, and of the harmony, and respect
necessary for stability within the society of the United
States, Donald John Trump has with his statements done
more than simply insult individuals and groups of Ameri-
cans, he has harmed American society by publicly casting
contempt on individuals and groups, inciting hate and hos-
tility, sowing discord among the people of the United
States, on the basis of race, national origin, religion, gen-
der, or sexual orientation, on one or more of the following
occasions:

On January 27, 2017, Donald John Trump issued Executive Order 13769 providing for a partial shutdown

1 of immigration from mainly Muslim countries, to fulfill a
2 campaign promise that read as follows: “DONALD J.
3 TRUMP STATEMENT ON PREVENTING MUSLIM
4 IMMIGRATION (New York, NY) December 7th, 2015—
5 Donald J. Trump is calling for a total and complete shut-
6 down of Muslims entering the United States until our
7 country’s representatives can figure out what is going on”,
8 thereby casting contempt upon Muslims, inciting hate and
9 hostility, and sowing discord among the people of the
10 United States on the basis of religion.

11 On July 26, 2017, Donald John Trump made a pub-
12 lic statement substantially as follows: “After consultation
13 with my Generals and military experts, please be advised
14 that the United States Government will not accept or
15 allow Transgender individuals to serve in any capacity in
16 the U.S. Military. Our military must be focused on deci-
17 sive and overwhelming victory and cannot be burdened
18 with the tremendous medical costs and disruption that
19 transgender in the military would entail”, and thereby
20 casting contempt on transgender individuals, inciting hate
21 and hostility, and sowing discord among the people of the
22 United States on the basis of gender.

23 On September 23, 2017, Donald John Trump made
24 a public statement substantially as follows: “Wouldn’t you
25 love to see one of these NFL owners, when somebody dis-

1 respects our flag, to say, ‘Get that son of a bitch off the
2 field right now, out, he’s fired? He’s fired!’ ” thereby cast-
3 ing contempt on professional football players who engaged
4 in constitutionally protected protests pertaining to allega-
5 tions of police misconduct with regard to racial minorities,
6 as well as casting contempt on the professional players’
7 mothers by calling the mothers “bitches”, thereby inciting
8 hate and hostility, and sowing discord among the people
9 of the United States on the basis of race and gender.

10 On September 30, 2017, Donald John Trump made
11 a public statement substantially as follows: “They want
12 everything to be done for them when it should be a com-
13 munity effort”, in the aftermath of Hurricane Maria
14 thereby casting contempt on Puerto Rican citizens of the
15 United States, inciting hate and hostility, and sowing dis-
16 cord among the people of the United States based on na-
17 tional origin and race.

18 On October 3, 2017, Donald John Trump made a
19 public statement substantially as follows: “I hate to tell
20 you, Puerto Rico, but you’ve thrown our budget a little
21 out of whack because we spent a lot of money on Puerto
22 Rico, and that’s fine, we’ve saved a lot of lives”, but Don-
23 ald John Trump did not make similar comments about
24 Texas or Florida in the aftermath of Hurricane Harvey
25 or Hurricane Irma, treating the Puerto Rican citizens of

1 the United States disparately, thereby casting contempt
2 on Puerto Ricans, inciting hate and hostility, and sowing
3 discord among the people of the United States based on
4 national origin and race.

5 On October 19, 2017, Donald John Trump made a
6 public statement substantially as follows: “The Fake News
7 is going crazy with wacky Congresswoman Wilson (D),
8 who was SECRETLY on a very personal call, and gave
9 a total lie on content!”, thereby casting contempt on an
10 African-American female Member of Congress, inciting
11 hate and hostility, and sowing discord among the people
12 of the United States based on gender and race.

13 On October 21, 2017, Donald John Trump made a
14 public statement substantially as follows: “I hope the Fake
15 News Media keeps talking about Wacky Congresswoman
16 Wilson in that she, as a representative, is killing the Dem-
17 ocrat Party!” thereby casting contempt on an African-
18 American female Member of Congress, inciting hate and
19 hostility, and sowing discord among the people of the
20 United States based on gender and race.

21 On October 22, 2017, Donald John Trump made a
22 public statement substantially as follows: “Wacky Con-
23 gresswoman Wilson is the gift that keeps on giving for
24 the Republican Party, a disaster for Dems. You watch her
25 in action & vote R!” thereby casting contempt on an Afri-

1 can-American female Member of Congress inciting hate
2 and hostility, and sowing discord among the people of the
3 United States based on gender and race.

4 In all of this, the aforementioned Donald John
5 Trump has, by his statements, brought the high office of
6 President of the United States in contempt, ridicule, dis-
7 grace and disrepute, has sown discord among the people
8 of the United States, has demonstrated that he is unfit
9 to be President, has betrayed his trust as President the
10 United States to the manifest injury of the people of the
11 United States, and has committed a high misdemeanor in
12 office.

13 Therefore, Donald John Trump, by causing such
14 harm to the society of the United States, is unfit to be
15 President, warrants impeachment, trial, and removal from
16 office.
