Advisory Clarification

Dear HD 105 Voter:

Recently, the Republican Party of Texas mailed you two flyers which state that a federal complaint had been filed against Susan Motley for violating federal law by running for political office while holding a taxpayer funded job. At the time we sent the mailing, we believed in good faith both mailers were true, as we had been furnished with a copy of the purported complaint and told that it was filed and our legal counsel had advised us that the statement was correct. However, since that time, the Dallas Morning News has reported the Office of Special Prosecutor stated that they had not received the complaint prior to the mailings and that, because Ms. Motley received part of her salary from private funds and because of the source of the public funding, she was not in violation of federal law by running for political office, making the statements in the mail pieces erroneous. Consequently, the RPT has decided in the best interest of fairness and accuracy to mail you and everyone who received the prior mailings this clarification. We apologize for any confusion or misunderstanding this may have caused you and we apologize to Ms. Motley for any erroneous information that was disseminated.
