Background information for the Church @ Work:

I am the Founder of The Church @ Work (TCAW). A licensed, ordained non-denominational minister, I began an online ministry 17 years ago that has reached hundreds of thousands worldwide with devotionals, online counseling, etc. The messages have been used by pastors who have used them for preaching. Others have published these messages on blogs, websites, and in newsletters and magazines over the years.

In 2008, I began certifying Chaplains through TCAW. There are now nearly 100 men and women of all denominations - and none at all - located all over the USA and Canada, who are now certified as Chaplains through this ministry with all their training done via distance learning and at no cost beyond their small, one-time fee to join our ranks.

Employed as a Workplace Chaplain for a Texas nursing home chain since 10 years ago this September, I am serving two homes in Whitney and one in Grand Saline. I am a certified Chaplain with several organizations, however, since being certified through the Austin Disaster Relief Network (ADRN), I have been deployed to the Moore, OK tornado, the West, Texas fertilizer plant explosion, and am about to deploy to the flooded areas of San Marcos. Most recently, I self-deployed to serve the tornado victims of Van, Texas. I have also served as an Instructor at the ADRN Chaplaincy Academy, training other Chaplains to do this type of ministry, allowing many of them to serve as Chaplains in jails, hospitals, nursing homes and workplaces as well as officiate weddings and funerals, law enforcement, things the local church need not concern themselves with because our Chaplains are involved.
