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## Akilah Bacy Leads

Findings from a poll of likely 2020 General Election voters in Texas's 138<sup>th</sup> State House District

A recent survey conducted in Texas's 138<sup>th</sup> State House District finds Democrat Akilah Bacy leading Republican Lacey Hull, 48 – 42 percent. After Hillary Clinton narrowly carried this district by less than 1 point in 2016, Beto O'Rourke defeated Ted Cruz here by more than 6 points. Now, Joe Biden leads Trump comfortably, 53 – 43 percent.

Bacy keeps her lead throughout the survey. After balanced positive and negative messages for both candidates, Bacy ends the survey ahead, 50 - 44 percent.




Figure 1: Vote Progression
