Akilah Bacý Leads

Findings from a poll of likely 2020 General Election voters in Texas’s 138th State House District

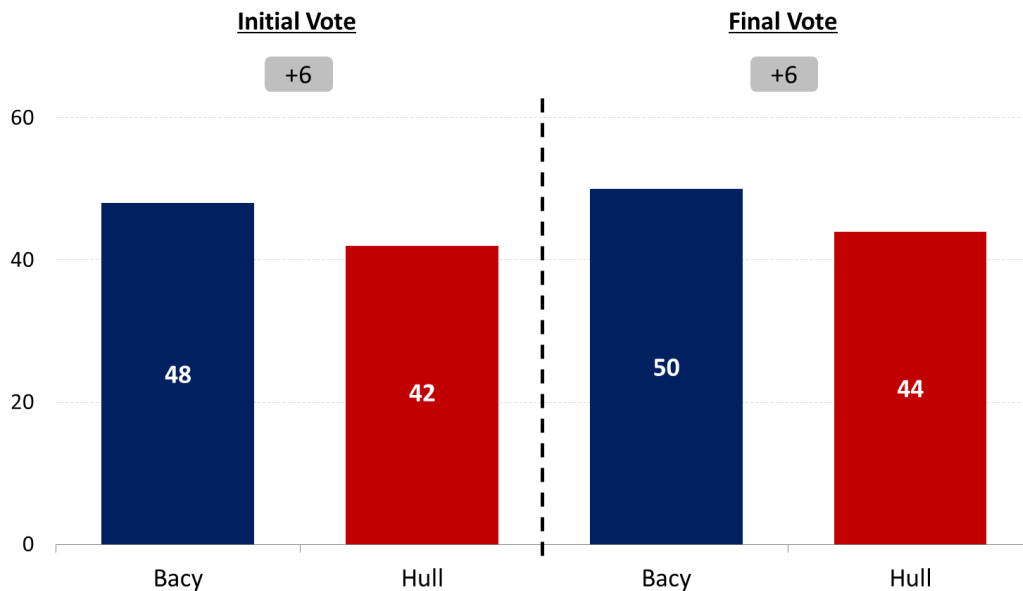

A recent survey conducted in Texas’s 138th State House District finds Democrat Akilah Bacý leading Republican Lacey Hull, 48 – 42 percent.¹ After Hillary Clinton narrowly carried this district by less than 1 point in 2016, Beto O’Rourke defeated Ted Cruz here by more than 6 points. Now, Joe Biden leads Trump comfortably, 53 – 43 percent.

Bacý keeps her lead throughout the survey. After balanced positive and negative messages for both candidates, Bacý ends the survey ahead, 50 – 44 percent.

The election is still a ways off, but Akilah Bacý is well-positioned to defeat Lacey Hull with an aggressive and well-funded campaign.

¹ GQR conducted a survey among 400 likely 2020 General Election voters in Texas’s 138th State House District from August 3-7, 2020. The margin of error is +/- 4.9 percent. The survey was conducted on landline (48 percent) and cell phones (52 percent).
