Cattanach Leads Meyer

Findings from a poll of likely 2020 General Election voters in Texas’s 108th State House District

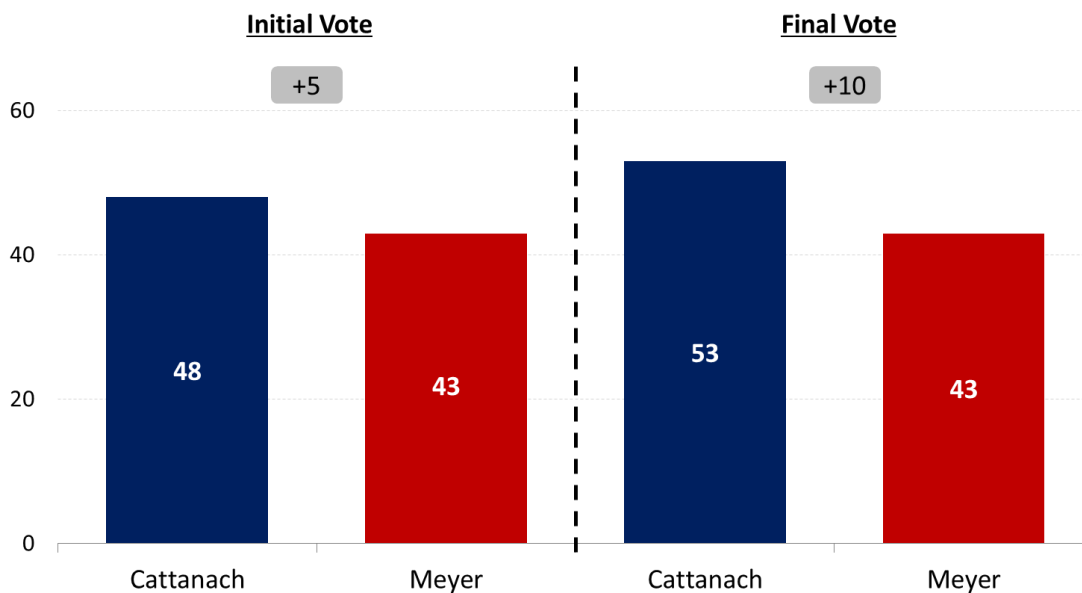

A recent survey conducted in Texas’s 108th State House District finds Democrat Joanna Cattanach leading Republican State Representative Morgan Meyer, 48 – 43 percent.¹ Donald Trump’s support has unraveled in a district that he lost to Hillary Clinton by 6 points and Ted Cruz lost to Beto O’Rourke by 15 points; Joe Biden leads Trump 59 – 36 percent.

Cattanach expands her lead to 53 – 43 percent after balanced positive and negative messages thanks to Cattanach’s compelling profile and Meyer’s record in Austin that voters see as out of touch.

The election is still a ways off, but Joanna Cattanach is well-positioned to defeat Morgan Meyer with an aggressive and well-funded campaign.
